**Chairman's Report:**

**Public Safety:**

Animal Control: 14 calls answered/received at residence, 2 citations, 10 warnings, 10 hours patrolled, 3 dogs picked up/placed in kennel, 1 dog returned to owner and 10 nuisance calls.

Police: 329 hours with wages totaling \$5,239. Fines for September total \$29,161.

**Road Report:**

774 hours with wages totaling \$14,839.82.

Most Township roads have been mowed.

Haul Road was patched in areas.

Road drag was used on Maxwell, Purdy Rd. Ext., Rock School, Aunt Clara, Five Points, Miller Airport and Laurel Roads.

Park – installed benches, removed poles, repaired benches and tables, painted boards for Covered Bridge, fixed tractor, garage door and sink.

Equipment - Massey mower, Truck 101 battery and brakes, repair hydraulic leak on roller, replace clutch in truck 104, clean tar off all trucks, clean around township building, remove and store roll spreaders
