Call to Order

The purpose of this public hearing is to discuss the proposed reauthorization of the LERTA ordinance allowing tax abatement for new businesses in designation areas.

Mr. Duerr explained that there were some revisions to the previous LERTA Ordinance regarding zoning.
-Mr. Grubbs stated that this revision should include the N-S District.

It was asked if the School District had any comments regarding the proposed ordinance.
-Mr. Turturice stated that they object to the whole thing.
-Mr. Reitz of the WCCED stated they were waiting to see what the Township did.

Mr. Grubbs stated that the ordinance should include the N-S district for local people.

Mr. Turturice stated that the School District agrees that they should go along with the Township.
Mr. Reitz stated that they had carved out specific areas and that LERTA was needed to help start large companies.

Mr. Turturice stated the N-S District is to be included.

Mr. Duerr stated that a corrected version was available.

Mr. Grubbs suggested changing the 4 year abatement to a 5 year abatement at 100%.

Mr. Morra asked if LERTA was transferrable if the property was sold.
-Mr. Grubbs stated yes.
